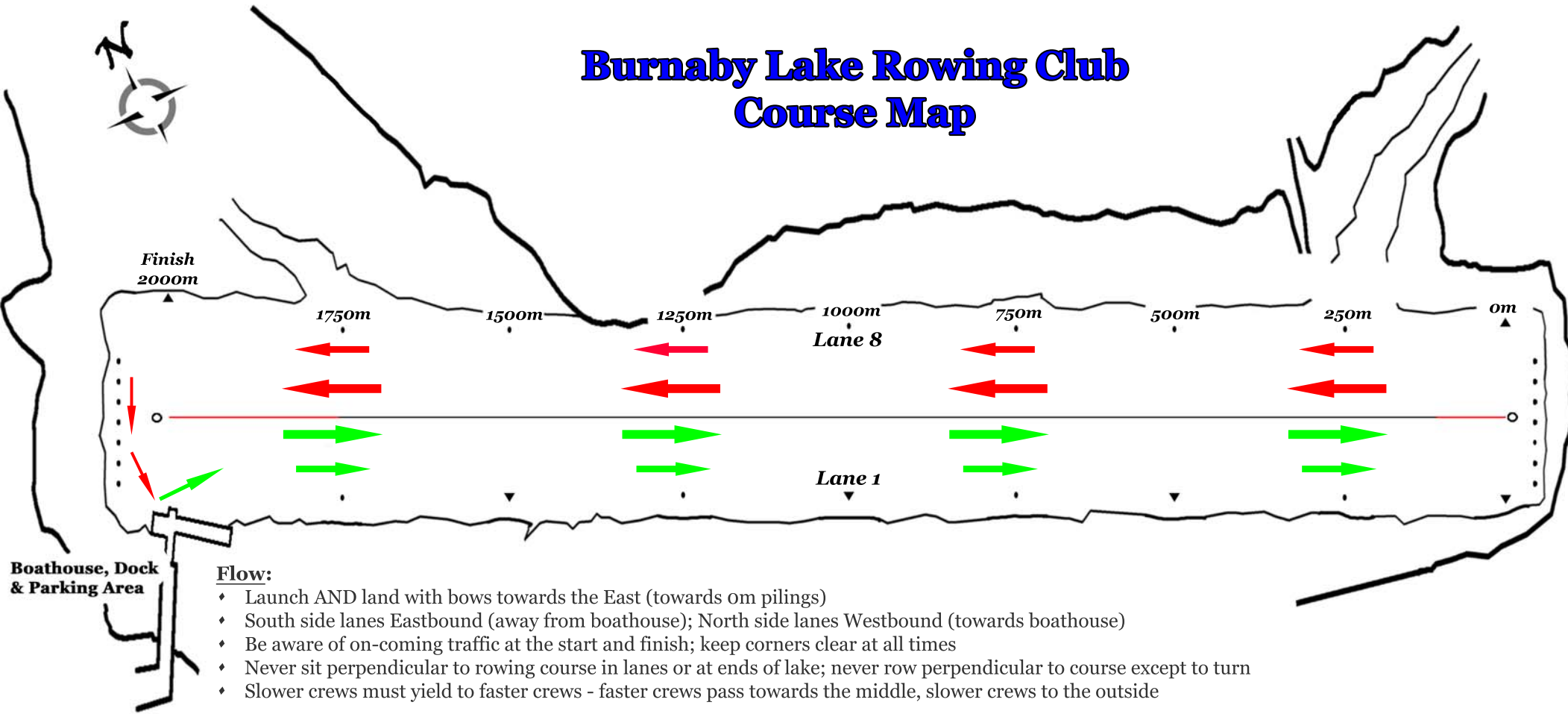


Burnaby Lake Rowing Club Course Map



Flow:

- ♦ Launch AND land with bows towards the East (towards om pilings)
- ♦ South side lanes Eastbound (away from boathouse); North side lanes Westbound (towards boathouse)
- ♦ Be aware of on-coming traffic at the start and finish; keep corners clear at all times
- ♦ Never sit perpendicular to rowing course in lanes or at ends of lake; never row perpendicular to course except to turn
- ♦ Slower crews must yield to faster crews - faster crews pass towards the middle, slower crews to the outside

Attention: The middle of the rowing course is denoted by a buoy line separating Eastbound and Westbound traffic. Safety buoys are usually placed approximately 30m ahead of each piling to serve as a warning of imminent danger. If no centerline is present, then large inflatable buoys will be placed at 150-250m intervals.
